

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, nationally, there are approximately 100,000 victims of child physical abuse each year and in 2021, there were approximately 154 in Montana – child physical abuse is a serious public health problem; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the earliest signs of physical abuse may prevent tragic outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the bruising clinical decision rule known as TEN-4 FACES can help screen children at risk for abuse by identifying bruising characteristics that have been demonstrated to determine abusive from accidental injuries; and

WHEREAS, the majority of child physical abuse victims are younger than four years of age, a vulnerable population whose safety and well-being relies on adults to intervene and protect.
