

Instructions: Fill in each required field (Date, Time, Zone Number, # of Elk)

Try to make at least one observation per day

If elk are in >1 zone, make an entry for each zone they occupy

Observer(s) initials:

If elk are totally absent from view, **record a 0 for the day**

Spotting address:

If elk are not visible due to weather, record a W for the day

Please Help us keep Missoula's Elk Wild! Mt. Jumbo is the primary winter range for 90+ elk that live in the Rattlesnake during the summer. If you see violations of the winter closure of Jumbo, the appropriate way to communicate the trespass is with the Missoula Police Department, using 911, but please note reported or unreported trespasses on this data sheet. All of Mt. Jumbo (except for on trail traffic to the "L" or along US West) is closed from December 1st - March 15th, for areas south of the Saddle road. The area north of the Saddle road is closed December 1st- May 1st.
